- As the body of Christ: *Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.* (1 Cor 3:16-17)

PLEASE COMMIT TO FAST FOR 40 DAYS

There are many ways in which you can fast. You can start off your 40 days with an absolute fast (i.e., no food and water) for three days. Or you might do a full fast (i.e., no food, only liquids). You can continue the rest of the 40 days on water, clear soup or juice. You can even fast by taking only one meal a day.

If you are unable to fast for the whole 40 days, please join us for 21, 14, 7 or 3 days. You may fast for several days, have a break and then fast again for another stretch.

Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life. (Rev 2:10)

And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved. (Mark 13:13)

In the eyes of God, life on earth is but for a moment. Yet many people live only for this life. They study hard and work hard for a good future but the truth is that whatever we do in this life is only temporal. Our real life is in God.

While we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal. (2 Cor 4:18)

And when Christ, who is your real life, is revealed to the whole world, you will share in all His glory. (Col 3:4, NLT)

We can only be faithful until death when we take on the life of Christ Who is called the Faithful One (Rev 3:14; 19:11). To take on His life, we have to die to our life and live life by the Spirit.

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. (Gal 2:20)

Therefore, brethren, we are debtors—not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. (Rom 8:12-14)

We are not called to be faithful to a denomination nor to anyone but to Christ Himself. To be faithful to Him is to be faithful to the word of God. Our Lord Yeshua is the Word of God (John 1:1). Thus, the apostle John faithfully bore witness “for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ” (Rev 1:2, 9).

Our Lord Yeshua is coming again, suddenly and soon.

Meanwhile, are you aware that we are in intense spiritual warfare? This war started in heaven (Rev 12:7) and continued on earth when, after the fall of man, God declared war between satan and man (Gen 3:15). Our enemy “the devil has come down to [the earth and the sea] having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time” (Rev 12:12). His aim is to drag as many of us to hell with him as he can.

Eventually, our Lord Yeshua Himself will return in person to engage satan in a final battle at Armageddon (Rev 19:11-20:3). Do you know this?

“These [i.e., the forces of Antichrist] will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful.” (Rev 17:14)

Whose side are you on in this war? Are you among those who are called, chosen and faithful? **If you are not faithful now, will you suddenly be faithful then?** There is a price to pay now.

No matter how the experts try to preserve the world, it will end. No matter how a person tries to preserve his life, he will die. How we live today determines where we will end up in eternity. Many can start very well but it is how we end that matters.

This Prayer Advance is to further alert you to the Lord's return. Prepare yourself so that you will not be shocked to find that you might have been standing on the wrong side all along. The warfare has intensified.

Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. (Matt 7:13)

For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ. (Phil 3:18)

Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. (Matt 7:21)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. (John 10:10)

WILL YOU STAY FAITHFUL TO THE END?

For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. (Matt 24:24)

And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations. (Rev 2:26)

He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. (Rev 21:7)

Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready. (Rev 19:7)

Faithful to the end.” Four simple words but slowly savour their meaning. Muse over them. Meditate on them and know what the phrase actually means.

It means unflinching devotion, unfaltering fidelity, an uncompromising stance and a distinct, unadulterated commitment. It means setting your face as a flint to do what God wants you to do. It means death of self-will. It means acute loneliness, humiliation, pain and affliction. It is drinking the cup that you find abhorrent. It is entering into your personal Gethsemane to transact with the Father and, like Jesus, offer up prevailing prayers with intense crying in order to triumph over the flesh to do the Father's will – to be faithful to the end.

If we want to be faithful to the end, if we want to withstand the demonic floods that will come with the rising of the antichrist and his one-world government to shake and devastate us in the days ahead, then **we must build strong fundamentals and have good regularities now.** Denying self and living the preeminence of Jesus Christ daily is building that

strong fundamental and good regularity – things that modern Christianity has forsaken.

Paul told the Christians at Rome that God could establish or keep them “firmly rooted to the end” only according to ‘his’ gospel. What gospel did Paul preach? Which gospel was Paul's gospel? The gospel of **Jesus Christ and Him crucified.** Paul knew **that only life in its crucified state will have the strength to carry us through all the extremities in life and keep us faithful to the end.** Let us return to this gospel before it is too late.

“Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery kept secret since the world began but now made manifest.” (Romans 16:25-26a)
